



- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATION OF ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES PRIOR TO EXCAVATING PLANT PITS.
- 2. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A 6" MINIMUM DEPTH OF TOPSOIL FOR ALL LAWN AREAS. WATER AS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH TURF.
- 3. ALL TREE AND SHRUB PLANTING BEDS SHALL HAVE 12" MINIMUM DEPTH OF TOPSOIL.
- 4. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A 4" MIN. DEPTH OF NATURAL NON-DYED SHREDDED MULCH OVER ALL PLANTING BEDS AND TREE PLANTINGS. TREE PLANTINGS SHALL RECEIVE A MINIMUM 4' DIAMETER MULCH RING.
- 5. PLANT SPECIES MAY BE ADJUSTED BASED ON AVAILABILITY AT TIME OF PLANTING. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SUBSTITUTIONS ARE SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- 6. ALL PLANT MATERIALS SHALL CARRY A FULL GUARANTEE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE, TO INCLUDE PROMPT TREATMENT OR REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF ANY PLANTS FOUND TO BE IN AN UNHEALTHY CONDITION BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT. ALL REPLACEMENTS SHALL BE OF THE SAME KIND AND SIZE OF
- 7. MAINTENANCE SHALL BEGIN IMMEDIATELY AFTER PLANTING AND SHALL INCLUDE WATERING, MULCHING, REPLACEMENT OF SICK OR DEAD PLANTS, RESETTING PLANTS TO PROPER GRADE OR UPRIGHT (PLUMB) POSITION, RESTORATION OF SAUCERS, AND ALL OTHER CARE NEEDED FOR PROPER GROWTH OF THE PLANTS.
- 8. WHERE A SIZE RANGE IS SPECIFIED AT LEAST 50% OF PLANTS PROVIDED SHALL BE OF THE LARGER SIZE.
- 9. APPLY SPECIFIED SEED MIX AT THE RECOMMENDED RATE THROUGHOUT THE DISTURBED UPLAND REVIEW AREA AND AS SHOWN ON THE PLAN. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CLEAR THE AREA OF WEEDS, STONES LARGER THAN 1 INCH, ROOTS, AND DEBRIS PRIOR TO APPLICATION. LIMITS SHOWN ON PLAN ARE APPROXIMATE AND SHALL BE VERIFIED IN THE FIELD BY THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR. ALL OTHER DISTURBED AREAS SHALL RE SEEDED
- 10. APPLY ORGANIC MATTER AND INCORPORATE THOROUGHLY INTO THE TOP 6 INCHES OF
- 11. CONTRACTOR/OWNER SHALL REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF ALL UNCLEAN FILL MATERIAL WITHIN THE DISTURBED UPLAND REVIEW AREA.
- 12. REMOVE REMAINING STUMPS FROM FELLED TREES WITHIN UPLAND REVIEW AREA AND RESTORE AREA TO GRADE.
- 13. GRADES WITHIN THE UPLAND REVIEW AREA SHALL BE RESTORED TO PREVIOUSLY EXISTING
- 14. ALL SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROLS SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE AND BE MAINTAINED UNTIL THE SURROUNDING SLOPES ARE STABILIZED WITH NEW VEGETATION.
