The above referenced *new* agenda items for the September 14, 2020 Planning and Zoning Meeting, and their respective supporting documents, have been received and reviewed. As submitted, these items, with the exception of Site Plans #P20-23 and #P20-24, are not expected to impact police operations and they require no further police comment.

As for #P20-23 and #P20-24, there is a concern that the proposed 24/7 automated vacuum service might negatively impact the Washington Avenue and State Street areas. The concern here, as we have witnessed with past numerous complaints at the Buggy Glow Car Wash on Middletown Avenue, is the potential for nighttime loitering by car enthusiasts, loud music and auto racing. Should the Commission approve these site plans, I would ask that some consideration be given to restricting the hours of operation to no later than 10:00 P.M.
