RE: Request for Variance for 118 Scrub Oak Road, North Haven, CT

Statement of the hardship that results in the request for a variance:

According to the Zoning Regulations of the Town of North Haven, effective March 1, 2007, Article VIII Section 6, page 114: "8.6.2.1: No fence or wall on any lot in a Residence, Residence Apartment, Office or Office Apartment District shall be constructed within the required front yard exceeding three (3) feet in height, excepting a necessary retaining wall."

Per the regulations above, the current zoning regulations allow only a three-foot fence in property owners' front yards. This particular property is located on a "corner lot," meaning there are three sides of the home considered as front yards or "road frontage," and no part of my yard can clearly be considered a backyard. Due to the fact that no part of my yard can clearly be considered a backyard, this presents a hardship that makes compliance with the current zoning regulations nearly impossible.
