ATTACHMENT TO SIGN VARIANCE APPLICATION

The applicant seeks a variance of Section 8.8.7.2 (3) of the Regulations to locate a free-standing monument sign of 30 s.f. within 11 feet of the front property line where a 17.5 foot set back is required.

The applicant is the owner of property located at 151 Washington Avenue. The applicant is in the process of re-developing the site to relocate its existing Citizens Bank branch in North Haven. The site is located in the IL30 District. The site was formerly used as the "Old Glory" retail center.

The applicant is desirous of locating its branded monument sign in the island located south of the site entrance driveway as shown on the plans submitted. There are certain unique hardships and circumstances that justify this modest request. First of all the island in question contains a tree that prevents moving the sign further back from the street line. Second, the stop bar for vehicles exiting the site is approximately 10 feet from the proposed location of the sign, more than sufficient room for an exiting vehicle to have sufficient sight lines for approaching traffic from the south. Finally, the previously existing plan sign, which this sign replaces, was non-conforming as to its size and setback. See attached photos.

As a result, the requested variance will not have a negative impact upon the site, the neighboring environs and will actually reduce a formerly existing non-conformity. For all of these reasons the applicant respectfully requests that the Board look favorably upon this variance request.
