





Because of the amount of work that was completed but that is still needed at 267C Kings Highway and because the Town of North Haven finds a 60-day extension to be very reasonable to address the remaining blight issues at the respective address, I am going to grant you a 60-day extension before suggesting to the Board that your address is placed on the Agenda for Citation.





Dear Marvin M. Morrell and Christopher Morell;

On August 7, 2019, and in my capacity as the Town of North Haven's Blight Prevention Officer, I received a verbal complaint regarding the existence of possible violation(s) of Chapter 84 of the Ordinances, Town of North Haven, the Blight Prevention Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "Ordinance"), at the property of 267C Kings Highway in North Haven, Connecticut.

Specifically, the Complainant has alleged that the property:

- Contains various unregistered motor vehicles and trailers on site;
- Contains storage of an abandoned hot tub, grills, ladders and most recently the property owner erected an unsightly canvas shed; and
- The property is going from bad to worse.

Section 84-3 of the Ordinance, entitled "Prohibition Against Blighted Premises" states "No owner of real property located in the Town of North Haven shall allow, create, maintain or cause to be created or maintained, a blighted premises." "Blighted premises" is defined as, "Real property, including any building or structure located thereon, which is and continues to be in the state of disrepair or is becoming dilapidated ..." The terms "state of disrepair" or "becoming dilapidated" are therein defined in the Ordinance under Section 84-2.

I have conducted an investigation of the allegations of the complaint and have determined that a

violation of the Ordinance exists at 267C Kings Highway as I observed the following conditions at said property which evidence the violation, including:

- Contains unsightly outside storage, including a hot tub, grills, trailers, building materials, tarped items, bikes, scrap wood, construction supplies, wheels, lighting, and lawn mowers to name some of the items, which need to be stored out of sight or removed;
- Contains multiple inoperative or unregistered motor vehicles and/or trailers parked on the property –visible from the Kings Highway driveway and neighboring properties;
- There are shrubs that need to be trimmed throughout the yard;
- The property contains several down trees and tree stumps laying on their sides, which need to be cut and removed in both the side and rear yards;
- There is overgrown grass, overgrown brush, and/or weeds in excess of one foot in height; and
- The property is unsightly and unkempt and a nuisance to the general public.

Pursuant to Section 84-4 of the Ordinance, you as the property owner(s) of 267C Kings Highway must remedy the listed conditions which constitute a violation of the Ordinance within thirty (30) days of the date of this NOTICE OF VIOLATION or such longer period as I may permit in my discretion as the Blight Prevention officer. Please contact me immediately if you believe that there are circumstances, which exist that warrant exercise of that discretion.

Please take note that, as the property owner of 267C Kings Highway, you may contest the NOTICE OF VIOLATION and liability for same before the Town of North Haven's Blight Prevention Board of Appeals by delivering in person or by mail, written notice of your request to do so, to me as the Blight Prevention Officer within ten (10) calendar days of this NOTICE OF VIOLATION.

IF YOU FAIL TO REMEDY THE VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE NOTED HEREIN WITHIN THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS AND YOU DO NOT DEMAND A HEARING BEFORE THE BLIGHT PREVENTION APPEALS BOARD WITHIN TEN (10) CALENDAR DAYS HEREOF, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A CITATION AND ASSESSMENT OF FINES AND DELIVER NOTICE OF SAME TO YOU. A VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$100.00 A DAY FOR EACH DAY A VIOLATION CONTINUES TO EXIST. THE DATE THE CITATION IS ISSUED BY THE BLIGHT PREVENTION APPEALS BOARD SHALL BE THE COMMENCEMENT DATE FOR SAID FINE. YOUR FAILURE TO PAY THE ASSESSMENT OF ANY FINE(S) BY THE BLIGHT PREVENTION APPEALS BOARD MAY RESULT IN THE ENTRY OF A JUDGMENT BY THE SUPERIOR COURT AND THE LEVY OF AN EXECUTION ON THE JUDGMENT WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE.
