After examining 4 Red/Black Oaks in front of 1 town Fair Tires, 165 Washington Ave, North Haven, Ct. per Town Fair Tire's request.

I have determined that the death of two trees and the continuing decline of two others is due to the compromise of their root systems, most likely during the construction of the building and drive way and front parking area. Breaking roots, compacting soil, and filling over root systems all contribute to the decline and eventual death of these trees. It is not possible for these mature trees to recover from such damage as there was nothing done to mitigate the damage when it occurred.

The three trees by the sign are dropping limbs and this poses a hazard to both pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

The single tree to the right of the driveway is hollow, losing limbs and in serious decline. It also poses a hazard to vehicle traffic coming in to the business.

These trees should be removed ASAP to mitigate the hazard to the public.
